# VISIT OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC TO THE INTEGRAL NATURAL RESERVE OF ROMBO ISLETS - ISLETS OF CIMA



It was with great honor that we received for the first time at the Integral Natural Reserve of the Rombo Islets - Islets of Cima the Honorable President of the Republic of Cabo Verde - José Maria Neves.

The President, together with his entourage, the Mayors of the Municipalities of the Island of Fogo and members of their respective teams visited our camp, where we had the opportunity to present the sea turtle and seabird conservation work carried out on the islet of Cima and also carry out other activities such as a cleaning campaign on one of the nesting beaches of the sea turtles and a visit to the colony of the loggerhead turtle.

From May 10 to 21, technicians from the Biodiversity Project were at the Integral Natural Reserve of the islets of Rombo - Islet of Cima for a training action and exchange of experience on seabird monitoring. This action was coordinated by our technician Domingos Montrond.

In the islet of Cima we can find 5 species of seabirds. namely: Pedreirinho. Pedreiro azul, Pedreiro, João preto and Rabo-dejunco. And during the training action the following work was developed: tracking of birds with GPS and geolocators, review and monitoring of colonies, placement of Japanese nets and control of threats.

# FIRST TRAINING ACTION FOR THE GUARDIANS OF THE SEA

The Guardians of the Sea Program aims to involve and empower fishermen to monitor and control infractions in their fishing areas and thus create in each one a sense of ownership of biological and natural resources.

In this sense, in partnership with the Center for Employment and Professional Training of Fogo and Brava, during 1 month the training was given to the fishermen of the Municipality of São Filipe.

Four modules were taught: First Aid,
Fishing Legislation, Fish
Preservation and Financial
Education. In total there were 4
Trainers and 22 fishermen trained.

The next steps of the Program will be the delivery of the safety and monitoring kits and the start of monitoring of the marine megafauna by the fishermen.





## PARTICIPATION IN THE MARINE SURVEILLANCE CENTER

We participated for the first time in the inspection nucleus currently existing in the Fogo and Brava region, in order to learn about the challenges of fisheries inspection in this region. The "fisheries surveillance center" is coordinated by the local fisheries inspectors and counts with the participation of the Coast Guard, the Maritime and Port Institute and the Maritime Police.

The partnership we are developing and strengthening is part of our Sustainable Fisheries Program, coordinated by BirdLife International Africa and funded by the Darwin Inititative.



### **MEETING WITH RESTAURANT OWNERS**



In the scope of the Sustainable Fishing Program, we have initiated contact with the restaurants on the island of Fogo, with the objective of starting the certification process regarding the provenance of the fish that is purchased and sold by these establishments.

The strategy is to **certify the restaurants** that will comply with a set of standards to ensure that the fish sold is of sustainable origin.



As part of the Endemic Plants Conservation Program, the production of endemic plants is a very important activity. Thus, we started the process of sowing endemic plants, in partnership with the National Montado Association, for the production of 12,000 endemic specimens in the nursery in Achada Furna, where, 5 species (Língua de vaca, Lantisco, Cravo brabo, Malagueta galinha, Funcho) have already been sown.




## 1ST SYMPOSIUM OF FLORA AND NATURAL RESOURCES OF THE CABO VERDE ISLANDS



We participated in the 1st Symposium of Flora and Natural Resources of the Cape Verde Islands that took place in the new Campus of the University of Cape Verde, between April 20 and 22. We were represented by the Executive Director - Herculano Dinis, who presented an oral communication in plenary on the theme: Associação Projecto Vitó: Priority Actions for Biodiversity Conservation in the Cabo Verde Islands. Also, the Executive Director was moderating session 4 of the symposium program entitled: "Patterns of diversity in terrestrial and aquatic environments of Cabo Verde."

On the occasion of the symposium the book "Guia Ilustrado da Flora e Vegetação da Reserva Natural de Santa Luzia" was also presented, where, together with Biosfera I, we provided logistical support as well as participated in the co-authorship of Chapter II.



## **ENVIRONMENTAL WEEK - TAOLA+**

In the scope of the Environmental Week promoted by the Cape Verde Environmental Conservation Network - TAOLA+, the members representing this Network met with the Parliamentary Specialized Commission for Economy, Environment and Spatial Planning, to present the results of the Project "Dialogue on public policies for integrative and innovative marine and coastal environment management in Cape Verde".

The meeting also served to establish collaborative ties between TAOLA+ and the Specialized Committee.





As part of the Environmental Week promoted by TAOLA+, a meeting was held on May 16 between the National Directorate of Environment and representatives of all environmental NGOs in Cabo Verde.

The meeting was a crucial moment for the discussion of various themes related to environmental conservation in Cabo Verde. We were represented by the Executive Director - Herculano Dinis, who discussed the major issues involving Biodiversity Conservation on the islands of Fogo and Brava, and also on the Rombo Islets Integral Natural Reserve.







## **CLEAN-UP** CAMPAIGN ON THE SPAWNING **BEACHES**

With the approach of the Sea Turtle spawning season, we have been to the beaches of Santa Catarina (Praia Grande, Fajã and Alcatraz), São Filipe (Fonte Bila. Nossa Senhora Encarnação, Vale de Cavaleiros, Salinas, Sopra and Praia Grande ) and Mosteiros (Praia Guente, Praia Caís and Fajãzinha), where, together with local partners, we have carried out cleaning campaigns.







### **CAPTURE OF SEA TURTLE IN SÃO FILIPE**



During the morning prospection carried out on the beaches of the city of São Filipe, our technicians found a slaughtered turtle in the possession of the offenders. The offenders immediately left the scene and the National Police was called in.

#### **RESCUING A SEA TURTLE**



A sea turtle - Caretta caretta was found in the Port of Vale de Cavaleiros by a fisherman - Julio Lopes. We were on site along with the Veterinarian - Janice Silva, who proceeded with the medication of the animal for three days. The turtle was very weak, with many parasites and fortunately it recovered and was returned to its natural habitat.

### FIRST SEA TURTLE ACTIVITIES ON ILHÉU DE CIMA



Sea turtle activity only intensifies in the Integral Nature Reserve of the Rombo's islets - Cima islet, which allows us to further reaffirm that the islet of Cima is a true biodiversity hotspot.



We held the "Training on Monitoring and Protection of Sea Turtles" directed to the Monitors of the nesting beaches of the island of Fogo and the islet of Cima. The training lasted 2 days, and its main objective was to train the monitors for a good performance of their work during the season.

Through the partnership with the Maio Biodiversity Foundation, the technician Jairson da Veiga gave the theoretical training covering different topics such as: Biology, Ecology and Monitoring of Sea Turtles, Nest Translocation. And we also went to Fonte Bila beach for a practical session.







On the last day of the training we had the presence of the Maritime and Port Institute Delegate from the Island of Fogo - Marino Rodrigues, who talked a little about the Legislation of Sea Turtles.
